

Dear Families,

We are gearing up to begin the 2020-2021 school year. The first day of school for all students is **Tuesday, September 8, 2020**. This school year will be like none other as we will begin our classes remotely from your home. As soon as possible, we will be sending out important detailed information via Facebook/Class Dojo/School Website regarding Chromebook/Material distribution (i.e. pick up dates and times). Until then please see the additional information below:

1. **Student Schedules**- Student schedules will be available from the classroom teachers. They will be sending information regarding their daily schedules. In general, students will be LIVE online, daily which starts like a typical school day at 8:05 with Social Emotional and Character Development lessons LIVE on Google Meet. Students will join LIVE lessons throughout the day in addition to having independent work time.

2. **Student Supply Lists**- Student supply lists are available on the schools website www.imaginesullivant.org. Given that we don't know exactly how school will look all year, students still need to have supplies ready in the event that we return back to the school. In addition, please have supplies available and organized for your children at home. Supplies include, pencils, paper, markers, crayons, scissors, glue, etc. Your child's teacher can provide additional guidance on supplies.

3. **Home Learning Space** – organize a space for your child at home that can serve as a home learning space. A location that is free of distractions and organized with the materials your child needs to be a successful learner.

4. **Student Attendance and Records**- Students will be expected to attend the LIVE lessons daily and engage with the lessons and assignments. Attendance will be taken as usual and truancy laws are still in effect.
