a. Universal and correct wearing of masks:

Sullivant Ave. Community School will follow the CDC and county health department's requirements on mask-wearing.

b. Physical distancing (e.g., including use of cohorts/podding):

Each classroom will be set up according to a diagram specifying the location of all desks and equipment to ensure a distance of three feet between students and staff whenever possible.

c. Handwashing and respiratory etiquette:

Proper handwashing procedures are posted throughout the building including restrooms. Hand sanitizer stations are posted at each classroom and throughout the hallways. Proper mask wearing etiquette is posted throughout the building.

d. Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation:

Increased cleaning/disinfecting of buildings have been a top priority. A schedule and rotation has been established to increase the disinfection at the schools.

e. Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the state, local, territorial or tribal health departments:

If students are exhibiting symptoms, parents will be required to pick students up from school immediately. Parents will be referred to the doctor and a doctor's note released back to school will be required. If a student or staff has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the school will work with the local health

department to report new cases. In addition students/staff that have been exposed according to the current contract tracing and quarantine regulations will be reported.

f. Diagnostic and screening testing:

The school will screen students and staff exhibiting covid symptoms utilizing the screening tool offered by Franklin County public health. Students and staff will also be sent home to be screened by a health professional if exhibiting two or more symptoms. A note to return will be required.

g. Efforts to provide vaccinations to educators, other staff and students, if eligible:

Sullivant Ave. Community School will continue to work with the local health department to provide opportunities for vaccinations to all staff and students who are eligible and choose to receive the vaccination. In addition, the school is looking into partnering with the local health department to offer vaccines to the family on a designated date and time.

h. Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to the health and safety policies:

Special Education teachers and related service providers will collaborate with general education teachers to schedule and provide required services to students. Rotated pull-out classes may also reduce the student-teacher ratios. Special Education evaluations will be scheduled during the school day. IEP meetings will be scheduled during the school day. Meetings will be held in person, via phone or virtually.

2. Describe how the school will ensure continuity of services including but not limited to services to address the students' academic needs, and students' and staff social, emotional, mental health and other needs, which may include student health and food services:

We know that many of our students and their families rely on the Schools free breakfast and lunch program. Sullivant Ave. Community School will continue to provide these meals to all students. Social emotional, mental health and overall health needs for our staff and students will remain the utmost important. We will continue to work with United Methodist Children's Home to provide services to our students and their families. They offer in school programs and individual counseling for those who request it. Our staff continue to have access to EAP (Employee Assistance Program) for a variety of services they may need in this area that is offered with medical insurance. Our campus will continue to focus on Social and Emotional Learning in the classrooms daily.
